

## Expectations for Spanish 3 Honors

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**Materials needed:** Spiral notebook w/pockets or Spiral notebook and folder for handouts, Spanish-English dictionary (suggested/optional)

**Grading:** You will be graded on all four skills: speaking, listening, reading and writing.

Activities include:

Speaking-dialogues, informal conversations, prepared talks, class discussion

Listening-activities from text, dictations, videos

Reading-pronunciation, fluency, silent reading, group activities—

Writing-paragraphs, compositions, reactions, short answers, reports, projects.

Homework-hand-outs, on-line activities, projects

Tests & quizzes-includes testing in all four skill areas

Tests/projects—35% quizzes—20% writing—15% participation/speaking—20% homework—10%

**Homework:** Homework will be assigned on a regular basis (approx. 3 days per week). Daily homework will be graded with 0/50/100 at my discretion. Homework will be recorded in Power School on a bi-weekly basis (approx. 5). Longer assignments, such as paragraphs and long term projects, will be collected and graded.

**Tardy to class:** The policy as outlined in the handbook will prevail. Be aware that at the beginning of most classes, we will have a Q/A time. If you are late to class, it will impact your participation grade.

**Make-up work:** Schedule make-up work ASAP. You will have one week after returning to hand in missed homework and/or take tests and quizzes.

**Extra help:** **Seek help as soon as you can. Don't wait! It will only get more difficult.** I am available most days after school, during period 5 study hall and THS period. Make an appointment and get a pass signed by me!

**Responsibilities:** **Be prepared for class**

**No food is allowed in the classroom (including gum)**

**Use Spanish whenever possible**

**When you leave the room you must sign in/out**

**Remain Seated until you are dismissed by me**
